### SCHEDULE YOUR VISIT

Summer and Fall are exciting times to tour Camp! Tours and visitors will be allowed in a limited capacity, with strict guidelines to protect the health and safety of campers. Your visit will include a welcome, camp tour, and time for questions. Your visit will primarily take place outdoors.

### Tour Guidelines - Protecting Camper's Health

- All guests will be asked to complete a health questionnaire upon arrival.
- Tours are limited to groups 8 and smaller, with one tour occurring at a time.
- Tours will focus on the beautiful campsite while tours of buildings are not available.
- Campers and volunteers will be busy playing! Please expect to see the fun from a distance.
- Shared meals at camp are not available during the 2022 season.

# SAVVY ABOUT SAFETY

Before leaving your home and travelling to Roundup River Ranch, please conduct a personal health evaluation:

- 1) I feel unwell and/or have experienced any symptoms of illness, including COVID-19, within the past 72 hours.
- 2) I have been in direct, in-person contact with someone who sick or is experiencing symptoms typically associated with COVID-19.
- 3) I have been in direct, in-person contact with someone who has tested positive or has a diagnosis of COVID-19 within the last 14 days.

If you answered "yes" or "maybe" to any of the circumstances above, you should not travel to Roundup River Ranch. Notify your contact at Camp, and they will happily assist you with rescheduling your tour for a later date!

Upon arrival, your contact will ask the same health screening questions, to ensure that the tour is safe to proceed.

Your tour will primarily be outside, so masks are not required. This policy is subject to change without notice.

## **Directions and Parking**

**Directions to Camp** –8333 Colorado River Road in Gypsum, CO. \* Note: No cell service once you exit I-70.

**Arrival and Parking—** When you turn into camp, please pull up to the gate box on your left. Select the button "phone call" and then "Front Office" and a staff member will open the gate. Once through the gate, take the second left. Park in the parking lot next to the yellow and green Medical Depot. Once you park, please proceed to DJ's Junction, the brown two-story building.

#### What to Wear

**Apparel** – Casual clothing, layers, and comfortable close toed shoes are recommended for walking.

**Remember Sunscreen and Water** – Camp is sunny! Guests are encouraged to wear sunscreen and a hat and bring a bottle of water. Due to COVID-19, the tour will be outside



# Other Helpful Hints

**Cell Phones** – There is no cell phone coverage at Camp.

**Pets** – Due to camp policy, visitors are not permitted to bring pets to camp. The parking lot is in full sun and it is unsafe for pets to wait in the car.

**Photography/Videography** –Enjoy taking as many photos as you would like of the beautiful scenery. Please do not photograph any campers, volunteers, or staff.

**Emergencies**– Visitors are asked to follow the staff's direction in the unlikely event of an emergency.
