2020 SUMMER CAMP SCHEDULE

Summer Camp 1 June 10 - June 15 Moderate to Severe Asthma, Lung Disease

Summer Camp 2 June 19 - June 24 Neurologic, Craniofacial, or Dermatologic Disorders

Epilepsy and epidermolysis bullosa as a primary diagnosis are served during Family Camp only. Currently we are unable to serve autism, down syndrome, TBI, or FAS as a primary diagnosis.

Summer Camp 3 June 28 - July 3 Congenital or Acquired Heart Disease, Heart Transplant

For children diagnosed with congenital or acquired heart disease or those who have received a heart transplant.

Summer Camp 4 July 8 - July 13 Cancer, Brain Tumors, Sickle Cell Disease, Acquired Immunodeficiency, Bone Marrow Transplant, Blood Disorders

Children with sickle cell disease must live at an elevation of 5000 ft. or higher and be referred by their hematologist prior to applying to ensure their safety at camp's elevation.

Summer Camp 5 July 17 - July 22 Gastrointestinal Disorders, Liver Disease, Liver Transplant, Celiac, EoE

For children diagnosed with liver disease, gastrointestinal disorders or those who have received a liver transplant.

Summer Camp 6 Kidney Disease, Kidney Transplant, and their siblings July 26 – July 31

For children diagnosed with kidney disease and their siblings or children who have had a kidney transplant and their siblings. Hemodialysis is served during Family Camp only.
