Participants are welcome to publicly announce the meaning of beads they place in the Celebrate U Jar, but often it is a private celebration of friendship, firsts, accomplishments, joyous moments, and more! At camp, the Celebrate U jar is kept in the Cookhouse by the fireplace.



When we are filled with uncertainty, change in routine, and new challenges, the power of celebration and positive thinking grows. **Consider making your own Celebrate U jar using supplies you have at home.** Each day, take a moment to celebrate as a family – did you try a new recipe that everyone loved?
