Roundup River Ranch is a member of the SeriousFun Children's Network, the largest family of medical camps and programs in the world, which was founded by Paul Newman.

Roundup River Ranch opened its camp in Gypsum, Colorado in 2011 and, as of 2019, has provided over 9,000 camper experiences, all free of charge.
